Operable Unit 1 (OU-1)—Pine Yard

- Grading and seeding reinitiated in December 2021, but completion delayed due to weather
- Anticipate completion in 2022
- Much of the 44-acre Pine Yard outside of the wetlands is now ready for reuse

Operable Unit 2 (OU-2)—Contaminated Soil on Off-site Properties

- Cleanup finished at 9 of the 10 off-site parcels
- Removal Action Completion Report to be submitted to EPA in 2022

Former Main Plant Area (OU-3/OU-5)

- Revised draft Feasibility Study (FS) for OU-3 and OU-5 submitted to EPA and MDEQ in October 2021
- EPA provided comments to the Trust in May 2022.
 EPA, MDEQ and the Trust are working to finalize FS
- EPA expects to issue proposed plan identifying a preferred cleanup alternative in Summer 2022

Moss Street to Waterworks Road Ditch Project

- Cleanup completed in late 2021
- City of Columbus accepted the ditch restoration work in April 2022
- Removal Action Completion Report approved by EPA in April 2022

As our work progresses, estimated completion dates may change.
